4. FIRST AID MEASURES

Inhalation: Remove victim to fresh air. Lay patient down. Keep warm and rested. Seek medical assistance.

Skin contact: Remove contaminated clothes, wash before reuse. Wash skin with plenty of soap and water. If swelling, redness, blistering or irritation occurs seek medical assistance.

Eye contact: Immediately irrigate with copious quantities of water for 15 minutes. Eyelids to be held open. Remove contact lenses. Urgently seek medical assistance.

Ingestion: Immediately rinse mouth with water. Give water to drink. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING. Seek immediate medical assistance.

5. FIRE-FIGHTING MEASURES

6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

7. HANDLING AND STORAGE

Handling: Avoid skin and eye contact and inhaling dust.

Storage: Store in a covered, cool and well ventilated area. Keep containers closed when not in use.

8. EXPOSURE CONTROLS/PERSONAL PROTECTION

Personal Protection: The following personal protective equipment should be worn. Safety glasses, goggles or face shield as appropriate. Rubber gloves. Appropriate protective clothing. Suitable respirator. Avoid all contact. Wash contaminated clothing and protective equipment before storing/re-using. Always wash hands before smoking, eating, drinking or using the toilet. Ensure an eye bath and water for washing of skin and rinsing of mouth is available.
